Horse Health Declaration forms

We are required, under Qld Biosecurity rules, to collect and keep Horse Health Declaration forms for all horses that attend our competitions and training days. These forms must be submitted electronically before riders mount up. Equestrian Queensland have provided an easy to complete, online form that can be found by copying and pasting this link into your browser, it can be found under forms on our website: www.rockhamptonequestriangroup.com.au. Download a copy and keep it handy to make it easy for your next outing. Riders who have not submitted HHD forms at competitions may be eliminated.

We're excited to be updating the Rockhampton Equestrian Group 2023 Queensland Off The Track OTT Leaderboard after the June dressage competition. We have a new leader in the Senior Dressage, Tavistock Square ridden by Taylor Hopkins is on 38 points, Balmerro and Renee Semple are sitting close behind on 35 points. The fourth and final dressage competition for the year will be held July 22/23, should be interesting. And in the Junior Dressage, Hayburner ridden by Billie Prow has leapt up to 2nd place with 31 points, only 5 points from our leader, Whipstaff Casper and Amarlie New on 36 points. The overall point leaders remain unchanged.
