Dressage Protocol Day with Alice Hurley Easter Friday, 15th April in the covered arena, CQLX. The Dressage Protocol Days we held last year were extremely popular so get in early. A wonderful opportunity to brush up on your dressage test riding and get a good look around the covered arena before the competition. Booking forms will be emailed to members. 20 Minute Protocol Session \$40, Half Hour Lesson \$65. or 45 Minute Lesson \$100, plus \$10 ground hire fee.

Trot Pole Clinic with Alice Hurley, to be held at the Crompton Park Pony Club grounds on Sunday 24th April. Trot poles are a great way to improve your horse's balance and coordination while developing suppleness, strength, power and cadence. The cost will be \$45 per lesson plus \$10 ground fee per horse. Horses will be in groups of three. There will be poles only, no jumping. A booking form has been emailed to members.





Show Jumping Training Day at the Crompton Park Hack & Pony Club on Monday 2nd May. Kay Orr and Bonita Floyd will provide instruction in the morning, after lunch riders will walk, then ride a course. Heights will start at 30cm through to whatever height riders request. It will be a great opportunity for riders and horses to practise competing in a relaxed, stress-free environment. The cost will be \$55 for the day, plus \$10 ground hire fee.

2022 EQ Leaderboard

ATTENTION EA MEMBERS – We need you to nominate your chosen club.

Throughout the year we will run three show jumping and three dressage competitions



which will include EQ Leaderboard classes. Just by competing in these events, horse and rider combinations will receive points towards the end of year awards. To be eligible, horse/rider combinations must have participated in at least 3 eligible events hosted by at least 2 different Clubs.

As well as the individual awards, EQ run an Interclub Challenge. Participants are required to nominate which Club they are representing for the 2022 Interclub Challenge. This can be done at any time during the year. PARTICIPANTS CANNOT CHANGE THEIR CLUB NOMINATION AFTER IT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED. BIOSECURITY HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION FORMS

Under the Biosecurity Act 2014, organisers of horse events must keep records of each horse that has attended their event. For more information, go to https://www.daf.qld.gov.au/.../horse-registration-and...

Horse Health Declaration Forms may be submitted electronically. Riders may scan or photograph and email or text the forms to us after the draw is done for all our competitions. For riders who prefer the hard copies, they are able to hand them in on the day of the competition. We then store the forms for two years, as required by the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries.

It's always important to consider your horse's health before heading off to a competition or training day, if he/she hasn't been eating well or doesn't seem their usually self, take a minute to check his/her temperature before leaving home.

This Easter means Dressage. We will be at Austadium, CQLX Gracemere, on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Friday, we start the weekend with a Prep-Elem Dressage Protocol & Coaching day with International FEI Rider, EA Judge & EA Level 2 Dressage Coach, Alice Hurley. Saturday morning will be arena familiarisation from 8am to 11am. Riders who are nominated to compete on Saturday and/or Sunday will have the opportunity to ride their nominated horses in the covered arena. Saturday afternoon and all day Sunday will be dressage competition.
