What is Concussion?



A concussion is a short-term disturbance to normal brain function due to a knock to the head or body.

Connectivity run a FREE 15-minute course which educates coaches, umpires, staff, volunteers, parents and other interested people to recognise and manage a concussion injury in a sporting context.

While there is no concussion-proof helmet, an equestrian helmet can help protect you or your child or teen from a serious brain or head injury. The following information was taken from www.cdc.gov/headsup.

Get a good fit. So often we see riders present for gear check at our events with their chin straps hanging loosely below their chins. Chin straps should be centred under the rider's chin, and fit snugly so that no more than one or two fingers fit between the chin and the strap. Have the rider open their mouth wide...big yawn! The helmet should pull down on their head. If not, the strap needs to be tighter. Once the chin strap is fastened, the helmet should not move in any direction, back-to-front or side-to-side.

Coverage Helmets should not sit too high or low on rider's head. To check, make sure the front rim of the helmet is about 2.5cms above the rider's eyebrows, and the back of the helmet does not touch the top of the rider's neck. Vision Make sure you can see the rider's eyes and that he/she can see straight-forward and side-to-side

EA Dressage Stewards

From 1 January 2024, Equestrian Australia require all official (competitive) dressage competitions to be observed by an EA accredited Dressage Steward. We have only just started running competitive dressage classes in Rockhampton this year, first time since 2018. It would be great if we could continue to run competitive competitions so we really need at least one steward in Rockhampton if possible. A steward is a bit like a referee, they make sure all the rules are being followed which helps protect the welfare of the horse and ensures fair play. Please let us know if you are interested in becoming an EA Dressage Steward and we will help you through the accreditation process.

Horse Health Declaration forms

We are required, under Qld Biosecurity rules, to collect and keep Horse Health Declaration forms for all horses that attend our competitions and training days. These forms must be submitted electronically before riders mount up. Equestrian Queensland have provided an easy to complete, online form that can be found under forms on our website:

Download a copy and keep it handy to make it easy for your next outing. Riders who have not submitted HHD forms at competitions may be eliminated.
