## Conditions of Entry:

- Equestrian Australia rules apply. The EA dressage rules and dressage tests are available from the EA web site: <https://www.equestrian.org.au/dressage-rules>
- Rule 4.8.5 **All horses must wear Horse Identification Numbers** on either the bridle or saddle blanket. Request for ID number form for unofficial horses can be found at [www.rockhamptonequestriangroup.com.au](http://www.rockhamptonequestriangroup.com.au).
- Rule 5.2 **All helmets must be tagged**
- Riders in classes 1 to 3 must be REGI members, Event Membership available - \$25 for the weekend.
- Riders in classes 4 to 11 must be EA members and their horses must hold a competition license.
- Riders in Competitive Classes may also compete in Club Classes provided they are REGI Members or REGI Event Members.
- Each rider may enter a maximum of 2 horses, each horse can compete in a **maximum of two** classes per day, in 2 consecutive levels
- Horses must be ridden by the same rider in both tests
- Competitive riders will be permitted to ride on the sand arena for 5 minutes prior to the commencement of their test. The judge will sound the horn after 5 mins and the rider will commence their test without leaving the arena
- **If insufficient numbers of Competitive riders, Club Classes will be added to the program**
- No refunds after the closing date unless accompanied by a vet or doctor's certificate, 25% admin fee will be deducted
- Dogs must be restrained at all times
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time
- A fully completed Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration form must be emailed to [regihhd@yahoo.com](mailto:regihhd@yahoo.com) or text to 0418 188 925 prior to competing
- Non-powered camping is available, cost is \$10 per night, to be booked with entries.
