If you wish to participate in any of the events (including the Super Cruise) you must enter your vehicle and register for driving events with the Office at the Showgrounds next to the Grandstand. There are separate fees for the Bill Henderson Observation Drive and the Go To Whoa.

- **NOMINATION** – completed forms can sent to our email address OR pre-fill them and bring them on the day
- **FEES** – pay your entry fees for the weekend at the Main Gate, and Nomination fees at the Office.
NO EFTPOS AT THE OFFICE – NO ATM'S AT THE EVENT – BRING CASH
- **JUDGING** – to ensure you get the best score you can, make sure you have...
 - Your bonnet open
 - Your boot open
 - Your interior to be able to be judged (wind a window down or door open)
- **Saturday night Off-site event!** Dinner at the Civic Club and Trivia Night! Get your friends together in tables of 6 to 10 people for a night of car and general knowledge trivia. Tickets will be available again via Eventbrite for ease of organising for the Club. More info will be on the website soon.

Entering Your Vehicle

Nomination Forms are available from the Office on the Motor Show weekend.

Alternatively, you can download extra nomination forms from our website under "**DOWNLOADS**" tab.

Please ensure you fill out the nomination form clearly with as much information as possible for the entrant details and the vehicle details. Be sure to include your vehicle's Series and colour as well, as these details can be helpful to identify your vehicle. If your vehicle is registered, please ensure the Rego is included.

Completed Nomination Forms can be emailed to ctrc@outlook.com.au or submitted to the Office upon arrival at the Motor Show, along with your payment. Pre-payment is not available. There are no EFTPOS Fees at the grounds or office so please bring cash.

For those entrants who are planning on leaving Saturday, please advise the office at the time of nomination and collection of your Entrant Sticker so that the Judges have your vehicle judged by Saturday afternoon. If you could also arrange to have a friend or family member to collect any trophy you may win at the Presentation on Sunday afternoon it would be appreciated.

Nomination for Participation Driving Events Only (i.e. not to be judged)

To participate in any of the driving events, you must first Nominate your vehicle as per above.

- Super Cruise
- Bill Henderson Observation Drive
- Go To Whoa

However, if you do not wish to have your vehicle judged, please advise the office and we will note that on your Entrant Sticker to allow you to participate in the Driving Events, but your sticker will be marked so that the Judge will know not to look over your vehicle.

Go To Whoa – there is an additional form to be completed at the office on the day.

Selection of Categories

The Category that your vehicle is eligible for Trophies is determined by our professional judge. We understand that entrants like to pick their own categories, but this creates confusion on nomination, as well as “discussion” after prizes are given (i.e. what is Unrestored/Modified etc).

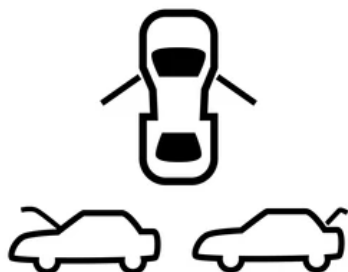
Our Judge Matt is always happy to answer any questions, and the club give out feedback forms.

Payment of Entry Fees

All Gate Entry Fees for people attending shall be required to be paid at the front gate **ON ARRIVAL**, and prices are located on our FAQ page of our website. No pre-payment of Gate Fees will be accepted. Entry fees for vehicles are paid at the Motor Show Office

Judging

Judging will commence **9am Saturday morning**. Please ensure that your vehicle is in a condition to be judged by this time with access to interior, engine bay and boot space available.

Once again, our Judge is Matt Gilkes - Owner, Designer and Trimmer from Inside Rides, all the way from Nowra in NSW coming to our show. Matt is a member of the Meguiar's judging team and has judged at events such as Summernats and MotorEx since 2002.

As you can appreciate, Entrants are very proud (and deservedly so) of their projects. However sometimes we, as owners, can be blind to the "third-party perception" of our vehicles. Please remember that the Judges, Executive and Office Staff are all volunteers, and people's opinion as to the "worthiness" of Award Recipients may vary from person to person. The Judge's decision is final, and no disclosure of scores will be given, so please do not ask as the refusal may cause embarrassment. **Our Judge however is always approachable to ask how you did and how you can improve your judging score.**

Camping and storage of Trailers

Camping is available for non-local entrants free of charge over the course of the weekend. Space availability is limited so we request that trailers are located away from Camping and display areas (see Motor Show Entrants Map on the website).

Should you be travelling with a group of friends who are not entrants within the Motor Show, we encourage non-participants please make use of the lovely Accommodation facilities we have within Charters Towers.

Rules of the Ground

Wristbands must be worn at all times.

- No BYO alcohol
- No Glass
- No Unrestrained Dogs
- No Dogs at all in the Motor Show arena (Showgrounds Ring)
- No pushbikes, skateboards or recreational vehicles to be ridden in the grounds
- No excessive noise
- Generators to not be used between 10pm and 6am
- Electrical leads cannot be run across walkways or roadways
- Camping and display sites must be left clean and tidy upon leaving.

Driving Events (for registered vehicles ONLY)

Super Cruise

The Motor Show holds two (2) Super Cruises with a police escort on Saturday morning and again on Sunday afternoon just before presentations. There will be a driver briefing before each event at the Grandstand. Please line up your vehicles at the Assembly Point marked on the Motor Show Entrant Map on the website after the briefing. This event is only open for Road Registered vehicles that have been entered and issued an Entry Number.

Please remember that all Queensland Road Rules apply. ***Please remember there are other vehicles and people around so no excessive spinning of tyres and kicking up dirt and stones or may be asked to leave. Let's be considerate of other entrants and the public.***

Bill Henderson Observation Drive

This year we have added a poker hand to the Observation Drive. The Observation Drive is held early Saturday afternoon, again only to Road Registered Entrants. Please assemble at the Assembly Point marked on the Motor Show Entrant Map on the website. If you have more than one passenger, you may have handicap applied to your score. Upon completion, forms and your cards must be handed back to the Officials who handed them out at the appointed area. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR ANSWER SHEETS TO THE OFFICE!** Once again, please drive sensibly and all Queensland Road Rules apply.

Winners are determined by the greatest number of correct answers first and, in the event of a tie, field ranking is determined by time elapsed to complete. Score results are not given out, nor are the answers.

Go To Whoa

Go To Whoa Qualifying will be at the time appointed on the event brochure or on our website once updated. To participate you must have entered your vehicle into the show prior to 1:30pm and show your driver's licence and sign an indemnity form. You cannot nominate another person to drive for you.

This event is capped at 30 entrants. **No Passengers. No Bikes. No EV's. Road Registered vehicles only.**

People's Choice

People's Choice forms are available at the office. You may vote for as many different cars as you like but you may only vote for each car once!

Car of Show

This award is given to the Entrant with the highest Judging Score.

Supreme Entrant Award

The Supreme Entrant Award is given to the Entrant with the highest combined score, who participates in all events over the course of the weekend (excluding Sunday driving events).

Scores from the following are tallied to determine the Supreme Entrant Award;

- Participation in Saturday Morning Super Cruise
- Ranking Score from Bill Henderson Observation Drive results
- Ranking Score from Go To Whoa Qualifying round
- Judges Score
