Product Care Guide

Thank you for choosing Resurfacing Cairns to give your kitchen, bathroom and laundry a new lease of life.

Your new surfaces will last just as long, if not longer, than the original if you follow these simple preventative care instructions.

- ✚ Ensure you do not use the surface for at least 36 – 48hrs after being handed over from Resurfacing Cairns
- ✚ Regular cleaning is important to prevent dirt & soap scum build up that will hide the beauty of your finish. Most cleaning can be done with a soft cloth & warm water. Good cleaners are Spray & Wipe, Shower Power, Easy Off Bam and all purpose liquid soap. These will clean the refinished surface without dulling the finish. Using products with harsh chemicals eg. bleach, chlorine, or products with coarse granules will possibly dull the surface and cause damage. These products are designed to strip and scrap.
- ✚ Use soft placemats under your commonly used appliances (toasters, kettles, etc) to prevent them from wearing your new surface.
- ✚ Do not place hot pots or pans directly on kitchen counter surface and do not cut on kitchen counters. Either could damage the counter and void the warranty. Use a cutting board, tea towel, soft placemat or cork boards to rest your hot pan on if needed.
- ✚ To keep your bath tub looking great no not lay soap, bottles or any other objects on the finished surface. In your bathtub, a hanging shower caddy or a shelf works well to store these items away from the surface.
- ✚ Do not drop sharp or heavy objects on the finish, which may cause it to chip. Contact Resurfacing Cairns immediately for repairs if this should occur. Failure to do so in a timely manner can result in further damage and could void the warranty.
- ✚ Be sure that your taps are not dripping after use. Tap fittings should be properly maintained by the owner & user to protect the new surface. Leaky taps will erode the new finish, causing it to crack and wear out prematurely.
- ✚ NEVER use a rubber or suction cup bath mat. Most mats will produce a reaction with the new surface when subjected to hot water.

Limited Warranty for Resurfacing

Resurfacing Cairns warrant the completed work against loss of adhesion due to workmanship for the periods of time indicated against each item on the invoice / quote authorizing the work to be completed. In the event of a claim, I will determine the extent of repairs required and advise you of timing in relation to my planned work program.

This is a limited warranty and is subject to the following conditions and exclusions:

Conditions

The surface must not be used or exposed to water until after the cure period indicated. You must, when possible, provide immediate notification of accidental damage or any other defect, and in any event not more than 14 days after the first occurrence. The warranty is customer specific and is not transferable.

Exclusions

- ✚ Physical damage such as chips and scratches caused by falling objects, tools, toys, shower screen installation or adjustment, or other mistreatment, whether or not accidental.
- ✚ Staining caused by chemicals, dyes, skin oils or hair treatments and dripping taps.
- ✚ Discolorations due to airless immersion caused by standing water, or water trapped continuously under jars and bottles, bath mats, face cloths, wet towels, soap slurry, etc.
- ✚ Warranty does not cover deterioration of sub-structure causing cracking or splitting of resurfaced areas.
- ✚ Rust emerging for concealed, inaccessible positions beneath the drain waste or other fixtures.
- ✚ Mildew and general yellowing of caulk, damage from rising damp in leaky shower bases or cracking caused by structural movement.
- ✚ Loss of adhesion cause by any of the above.
