State Government grants

The Club has recently been successful in securing Tasmanian Government grant funding under two programs:

- \$5,000 under the Sport and Recreation Recovery Grants Program to assist with clean up costs following the October 2022 floods.
- \$15,050 under the Sport and Active Recreation Equipment Grants Program.

The latter will meet 2/3 of the cost of two new electric carts and we are looking at raising funds to help meet our share of the purchase – around \$7 000. This could be sponsorship/naming rights of the new carts (our preference), or if necessary, we will





offer one of our older carts for sale to go towards our portion of the purchase cost. Please spread the word to local businesses who might be interested in cart sponsorship. If we need to revert to selling one of the older carts, we will call for expressions of interest, but we would prefer to keep them both as reserves when needed.




Vale
